Good Morning Everyone,

Monday morning temps are 27°, another cold morning. Today I'd like to dig the last of my dahlia bulbs then garden is ready to be tilled all except my fall red beets and carrots which are still good eating. The dahlia bulbs I hose off all dirt, let them dry off and store in wood shavings in a cool place but not freezing. Now that most of outside fall work is done I am working on fall house cleaning, then hopefully I'll get more sewing done. Have an order for more racoon hats to sew. It takes quite a bit of hand sewing but wasn't hard after the first one. Earlier I had made 20 in all sizes and colors using a quilted fabric for the lining. It takes one hide for each hat. Just by sewing them I decided they are warm hats.

Last week us ladies, our five daughters, three daughter-in-laws, and the two oldest grand-daughters went to Columbus shopping. We went to a few discount and bargain stores which was very interesting, there was sitting room only by the time we got home. Thanks to my sister-in-law for babysitting the children.

Men are about done with crops. Have about 80 more acres of corn to go, then bale that corn fodder for bedding yet. All corn fodder and soy bean wind now get baled for winter bedding, keeping the cattle barns dry. And what is not needed goes for compost in spring. This week plans are to start screening this year's crop compost and store in compost shed for winter, keeping it dry and ready to bag when needed. They also have a few orders to fill two truck load bagged and four semi load unscreened going to farmers for fall application.

Harvey's dad passed Oct, 24th at his home. He was almost 93 years old, buried in PA beside mom. Both our parents are gone now leaving us the older people. May we continue a life with integrity.

Duck butchering is on my list one of these days for our Thanksgiving dinner at son Wilson and Mabel's place. We

have not had duck meat in a long time. Wilson offered to help us clean them. It's a family favorite we like the mascor duckies not as greasy as the pecans are. Ducks are already at his farm. The day after Thanksgiving us women are getting together to fill shoe boxes for Bread of Life Ministries. Instead of spending money on Christmas gifts we decided to do this. Each family will decide on the number of boxes they want to do. We usually try to fill with usable things like hats, scarves, gloves, socks, and a few educational things like books, crayons, pencils, etc.

Christmas will soon be here. The beauty of Christmas is a blanket of snow, the blessing of Christmas is hope all aglow, the sharing of Christmas is a message that's true, the treasure of Christmas are friends like you!

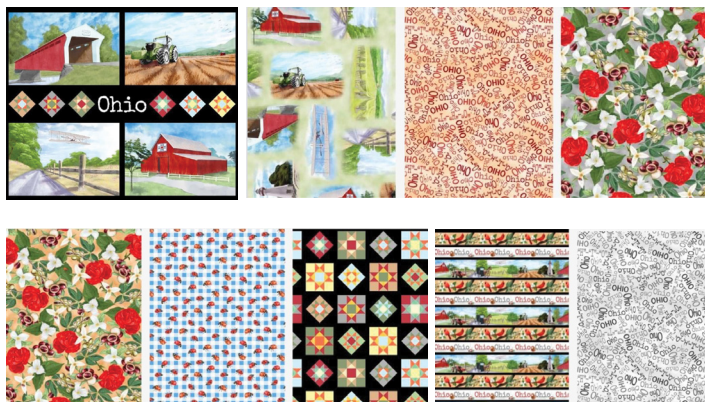

The Yucky Stuff (broth):

1 c. ketchup
1 c. vegetable oil or olive oil
1 c. vinegar
1 (3 oz.) pkg. crab boil seasoning (use kind that comes in a bag, available at Walmart (spice/seasoning aisle)
3/4 c. salt (broth should be very salty)
2 teaspoons black pepper
16 c. water

The Good Stuff:

| 6 (2 lb.) pkg. shrimp, thawed 1-2 green peppers, sliced | Add at 11:50 a.m. |

At 11:55 a.m., turn off the burner and let set for 5 minutes. Then strain off the broth once people are seated. Tips: Have ingredients cut up before broth begins to boil.

If inviting friends over, tell them to be there 15 minutes or so before you expect to have the stew ready. The potatoes will get too mushy if you have to wait on latecomers. The stew is best if served as soon as it's ready. Before adding shrimp, etc., check to see if the meat and potatoes are ready. If they aren't quite done, wait another 5 minutes, or so before adding the last ingredients. Once you've made it once, you'll sort of get the feel of it and don't be afraid to make time adjustments.

Dump onto cookie sheets or service trays and send around table. Or for a casual outdoor dinner, cover picnic table with paper towel and dump onto table. Everybody reaches in and helps themselves.

Dinner rolls and an ice cream dessert go well with the stew. Use different dips such as ketchup, sour cream, Ranch dressing and cocktail sauce.

Frogmore Stew

If lunch is at noon, proceed to make the stew as follows: The burner should be on high at all times. At 10:30 a.m., put broth on stove. It must be boiling before adding ingredients. Put all ingredients in a large, stainless steel pot, about 20-quart in size.
